## Here's how you can become one of the Elite

Bowlers must be a regular current league member in the center they are qualifying and their average must be 190 or above. There will be 2 scratch divisions

The Bill Hayes Tour 210 average or higher

The Gene Glasgow Tour 190 through 209 average

Average used will be your highest Buffaloe Lanes 07-08 yearbook average. If a bowler has no Buffaloe Lanes yearbook average, the bowler will use their highest average between their 07-08 yearbook and a current Buffaloe Lanes league average with at least 21 games.

First Round of Qualifying will be **Oct. 6<sup>th</sup>** through **Oct. 9<sup>th</sup>** after 9pm when lanes are available

Entry Fee \$40.00 Re Entry \$20.00

Bowl 4 games of qualifying in the center that you are currently bowling a league with Buffaloe Lanes

You may try to qualify as many times as you wish, but may only advance in one position

After qualifying ends on Oct. 9<sup>th</sup>, all scores from all 3 Buffaloe Lanes Centers will be combined. We will then take ½ the field to advance to the Second week of qualifying in each division. Bowlers may check the web to see if they advance or not. Pinfall will carry over into the second round of qualifying.

The second week of qualifying will be Oct. 13<sup>th</sup> through Oct 16<sup>th</sup> after 9 pm when lanes are available

There is no entry fee for this round of competition and there are no re entries

Bowl 4 games of second round qualifying in the center in which you qualified

After qualifying ends on Oct. 16<sup>th</sup>, all scores from all 3 Buffaloe Lanes Centers will be combined (8 game total). We then will take the top 6 bowlers in each division. These bowlers have qualified to bowl in the Tour Final on Oct 19<sup>th</sup> at Buffaloe Lanes North.

The top 6 bowlers in each division will compete in a stepladder final of one game to determine the Tour Final Champion of their division.

Pay out for this tournament is based on 1 in 6 bowlers. The 8 game total pins with handicap will determine winners per division.
